Towcester Brook District Councillors call for Care Village

Dear Mrs Morgan

We are writing on behalf of the residents in this area to ask that SNC commits to enabling the development of a much needed Care Village at Springfields for the future benefit of the community.

It is well recognised that there is a great shortage of such facilities in the South of the County: we are faced with an ageing population, increasing longevity and the quality of life issues that arise from these trends.

SNC has the opportunity to enable such a development and we ask that such a policy is adopted within the Towcester Masterplan and the specification now under discussion with developers.

The facility must include the dementia clinic, care homes and respite care facilities that are so badly needed.

Such a development would also lower the traffic impact from the current use of the site, create jobs and enhance the local environment and it should become a Council priority to see this delivered within the next 5 years.

I am pleased to be able to confirm that your proposal will be given active consideration in the light of the proposed growth of the town and the growing proportion of the Districts population which is elderly and requiring care needs.

As you will recall from the recently received Chase & partners Retail Study of the South Northants there is no case for a new large supermarket within Towcester effectively rulling out one potential use for the site.

- The green part of the prescription must be signed by your Doctor before the pharmacy can give you the medication - including for a repeat prescription.
- If you are due for a review and have not had it, the Doctor will not sign the green form and you cannot, therefore, get your medication.
