Since May District Councillor Andrew Grant has managed to secure a grant of £10,000 for the Vision Youth Cafe and County Councillor Rosemary Bromwich is in the process of giving grants to Vision and to Tove Valley Baptist Fellowship Youth Camp from her "Empowering Councillors Grants".

District Councillor Diana Dallyn has been working with SNC officers to get graffiti removed from buildings and to support the Vision Youth Cafe. We are all delighted that Vision has received money from the Waitrose collection and from Midsummer Music.

Along with the rest of your Conservative Councillors, District Councillor Andrew Wilby attended the exhibition regarding the Towcester Town Park development. We will all be working with SNC and WNDC to make sure the development is a credit to Towcester and will attract people to live, work and contribute to the prosperity of the town, as well as improve the quality of life for those of us who live here already.

We are also involved with scrutinising the Persimmon application for Towcester South and will be fighting on your behalf for the facilities, including the proper bypass/relief road which Towcester needs, and for the new development to be a part of the existing town not a separate add-on.

Rosemary Bromwich your Conservative County Councillor says:

I have just finished my year as the Chairman of Northamptonshire County Council and it has been a great honour to represent and promote our County.

This year has been very challenging and we have consulted widely about how decreases in public spending will impact on the County. Through the 'You Choose' campaign, not only has the Council organised public meetings but also launched a dedicated website and all the feedback that was received has helped to inform the Council's budget and priorities.

This February saw Councillors approve the County Council's Budget for 2011/12. Our Country is facing unprecedented financial challenges and the Council's budget reflects the local impact of a national problem as the Council will have to make savings of £73 million over the coming year.

As part of the budget proposals, the Street Lighting switch-off has now started to be rolled out County wide. All the comments that have been received by councillors are being listened to and I have already fed back complaints from local pensioners.

The review of all the County libraries is still in progress and I am confident that we will deliver a service that is better suited to today's needs. Our Towcester Library is planned to be relocated in the Civic Centre together with our Registry Office, as our present library is in need of many thousands of pounds of maintenance. We are looking forward to delivering a state-of-the-art world class library for Towcester which already has the support of staff and users.

I am also pursuing the need for a bus service from Towcester to Daventry and Danetre Hospital. This has been a concern of mine and was highlighted again in the recent Bus Consultation.

Andrea Leadsom sets up help group for Parents

Conservative MP Andrea Leadsom is setting up a charity to help families who struggle to form a secure emotional bond with their babies.

The Northamptonshire Parent Infant Project (NORPIP) follows the success of OXPIP, a similar project which she chaired for 9 years in Oxfordshire.

Andrea said, "My aim is that we will eventually offer this type of support for new families and their babies right across the UK. At the extreme end, homelessness, drug addiction, self harming, depression, criminality - the worst social problems - stem from the emotional damage done when the baby is less than two years old."

The service, which will start in September, will offer psychotherapeutic counselling to new families who are struggling to form a secure bond with their babies.
